- **Mentorship scheme**

1. In the mentorship scheme a Teacher (mentor) is assigned with a group of approximately twenty students (mentees). Around five students from first year engineering to final year engineering form a group of twenty.
2. Mentor meeting is conducted once in an alternate week. Various activities like career goal setting, presentation skill, communication skill, resume writing, aptitude test etc. are conducted in the meetings
3. Along with these activities, mentor has to keep the academic record of the mentees allotted to him in terms of their monthly attendance, academic results, co-curricular participation within and outside campus etc. and inform the same to the parents.
